### 1. HOW TO USE THE PORTABLE SLIT LAMP

#### 1.1 Adjusting Interpupillary Distance/Diopter



Adjust the interpupillary distance by rotating the prism box left or right to obtain an appropriate field of view through the eyepieces. Turn the diopter correction scale on the eyepiece all the way to the "+" side, then look through the viewfinder with one eye at a time and slowly turn it towards the "-" side. Stop when the reticle becomes clearly visible.

#### **1.2 Observing the Subject**





Using the grip, hold the main unit securely in your hand.



Hold the grip firmly with one hand and focus by adjusting the distance between the examined eye and the objective lens. Press the slit light button to activate the slit light.

#### **1.3 Disinfection of this Device**

Wipe the device with a soft cloth soaked in rubbing alcohol. Please do not spray rubbing alcohol directly on the device. For more information on cleaning the lens, please refer to "4.4.2 Cleaning the projection prism, the objective lens, the eyepiece and the Barrier Filter B<sup>®</sup> in the instruction manual.

#### **1.4 Mechanical Functions**



Camera button

Push to start/stop recording.

#### Back und light button

There are three levels of brightness. If there is no operation for 10 minutes, the light will turn off automatically.



#### Blue light button

There are three levels of brightness. If there is no operation for 10 minutes, the light will turn off automatically.

#### Main unit indicator

Lights up green when in use. When the battery is low, it flashes orange.

### Slit light intensity dial

To adjust the brightness of the slit light, turn the dial to the right to make it brighter, and turn it to the left to make it darker.



#### 1.5 Replacing Batteries

Camera indicator

Indicates the status of the camera.



- When the main unit indicator flashes orange, the batteries need to be replaced.
- Three AA Ni-MH batteries are required for the device.
- Please refer to the instruction manual for details.
- Camera functions do not work properly with alkaline batteries.

#### 1.6 Troubleshooting

### 3. HOW TO USE THE SL-19 APP

#### 3.1 Recording

#### Start Recording







Press the camera button on the main unit or tap "Record" in the app to start recording. The camera indicator lights up purple while recording.

\* You can select "R" or "L" to identify which eye to record.





#### **Stop Recording**



Press the camera button on the main unit again or tap "Stop" in the app to stop recording.



Tap back in the upper left corner to return to the data list screen. The recorded video is saved.





#### 3.2 Extracting Still Images

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#### **Automatic Extraction**



When you tap a recorded video, the focused still images are automatically extracted. Now you can select and save the images from the extracted images. \*The extracted images will not be saved automatically.

#### **Manual Extraction From Video**





If you want to select and save an image manually while browsing the video, press the Video button in the upper right corner. Play the video and pause at any point to select still image to save. Move back and forth on the frame by tapping the left and right arrow, or by sliding the scrubber.

#### 3.3 Browsing Still Images



Tap any image to display a still image.



Swipe right to see the previous image.



Swipe left or right on the screen.



Swipe left to see the next image.

#### 3.4 Zooming In/Out Still Images (1/2)

This function can only be carried out with saved still images.



Double-tap on the screen to enlarge the image by 2x.



Double-tap on the magnified screen.



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The original image is magnified 5x.



Pinch in/out on the screen





#### 3.4 Zooming In/Out Still Images (2/2)

Enlarged images can be moved by swiping them.







Saving Enlarged Images



Tap "Save Image" to save the enlarged image currently displayed on the screen.



Tap "Back" to return to the data list screen.

#### 3.5 Replaying Video and Extracting Still Images (1/2)

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#### Video Display



Tap the Videos tab.



Select the file you want to display.



Image extraction.



Tap the Video button.





#### Video Replay - Seek Function







Tap the image thumbnail to display the selected image.

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#### **Deleting an ID Folder**

#### Bulk Data Deletion (Becomes Available When Free Space is Low)



When available storage is below the required threshold a warning message will be displayed.



Tap "Available Space" to select files for deletion.

#### Sharing/Exporting the Data

It is possible to share recorded imaging data with external devices. However, some apps and functions will not be displayed to prevent accidental transfer.



Please be careful when handling recorded imaging data as they may contain personal information.





Tap "Share".





If enabling the "Do not show this message again" checkbox, this message will not be shown again.



#### Compatible apps are displayed.

The file is saved to the destination specified. File names may change during saving. Some settings may need to be adjusted in advance (depending on the selected app).

#### "Save to Files"

The file will be saved to a selected destination. The file name is added in this app.

#### "Save Image" (when an image is selected), "Save Video" (when a video is selected)

The file will be saved in "Photos" on your local device. File names may change during saving.

#### "Add to Shared Album"

The file will be stored on the iCloud online service. File names may change during saving.

For the specifications of the file names added by this app, please refer to the "Export Data Specification" chapter of the other manuals "Export function: Wired LAN" or "Export function: Wireless LAN."



### 4. HOW TO FINISH THE OPERATION

#### 4.1 Turning Off the Camera and Closing the App



To turn off the camera, press and hold the camera button for 3 seconds. Then the camera indicator turns off.

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#### 5.5 About the "Today" Mark and "Unedited Video" Mark

Still images/videos saved on the same day are marked with a "Today" mark in the display list.



For videos that do not have a still image saved, an "Unedited video" mark is displayed in the data list screen. Please be careful not to forget to save your records.



### 6. PRECAUTIONS

#### 6.1 Precautions for Using the Camera

- The camera will not work properly with alkaline batteries.
- The camera does not have an auto-off function.
- If the diopter is not adjusted well, there will be a difference between the positions where the microscope and the camera are focused.
- Since the live view screen consumes a large amount of battery power from the slit lamp, please refrain from using the live view screen except during medical examinations. We highly recommend an extra set of charged batteries with a battery charger ready to be exchanged during examination.
- For troubleshooting the app, please refer to the "Troubleshooting" manual.

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
